Nomination Procedures:

1. Each candidate must be nominated in writing by a current member of the SCWHA. The nomination letter should include why the nominee should be considered for this award.
2. Any youth seventeen (17) and under may be considered. He/she must have been a member of the SCWHA for a minimum of two (2) years. Owning or exhibiting a horse **IS NOT** a requirement.
3. Candidate must exhibit good sportsmanship at all times. Positive speech and behavior must also be exhibited.

Criteria for the Nomination of Horseman and Horsewoman of the Year Award

Nomination Procedures:

1. Each candidate must be nominated in writing by a current member of the SCWHA. The nomination letter should include why the nominee should be considered for this award.
2. Any adult who has been a member of the SCWHA for a period of five (5) years or more can be a candidate for this award. He/she must have contributed a service or services to the SCWHA. (Examples: Working at or for local shows or the state show: Obtaining sponsors: Working at or for the Annual Awards Banquet or Spring Fling). Owning or exhibiting a horse **IS NOT** a requirement.
3. Candidate must exhibit good sportsmanship at all times. Candidate must exhibit positive speech and behavior at any show exhibiting Tennessee Walking Horses. This conduct should be displayed not only in South Carolina but other states as well.
4. Candidates must be willing to accept a leadership role if needed. (Example: Board Member, Committee Chairman, etc.) Candidate must be a contributing member toward the promotion of the Tennessee Walking Horse (Example: Breed mares and Raise colts: Sponsor classes/ribbons at local or state show: Work with local youth groups to promote the Tennessee Walking Horse).
